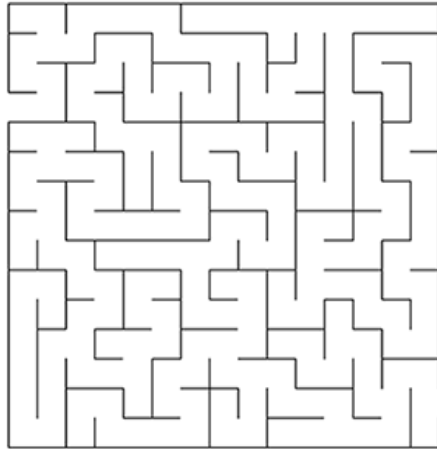
Sing Along
