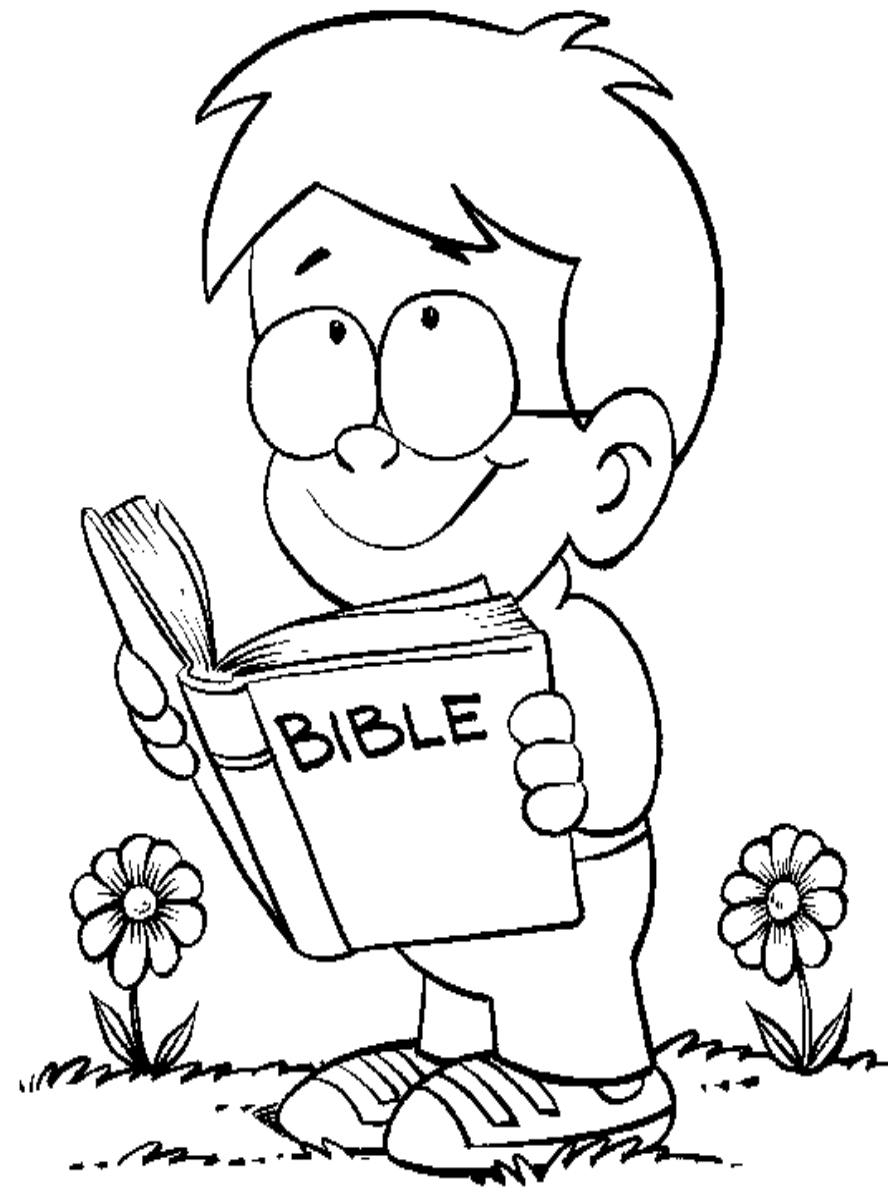
went  on the  (mountainside) and

whoever  humbles himself as a little  (child)
would be the greatest in the kingdom of . In the
 of Proverbs we  that a  's pride will
bring him , but a lowly spirit will bring him 
(honor). There are many "blessed" statements in Matthew
5: 1 - 12. Each of the "blessed" state-
ments describes a person who puts  and
other's interest above his or her own interest. We cannot
be blessed if we live  (haughtily).
