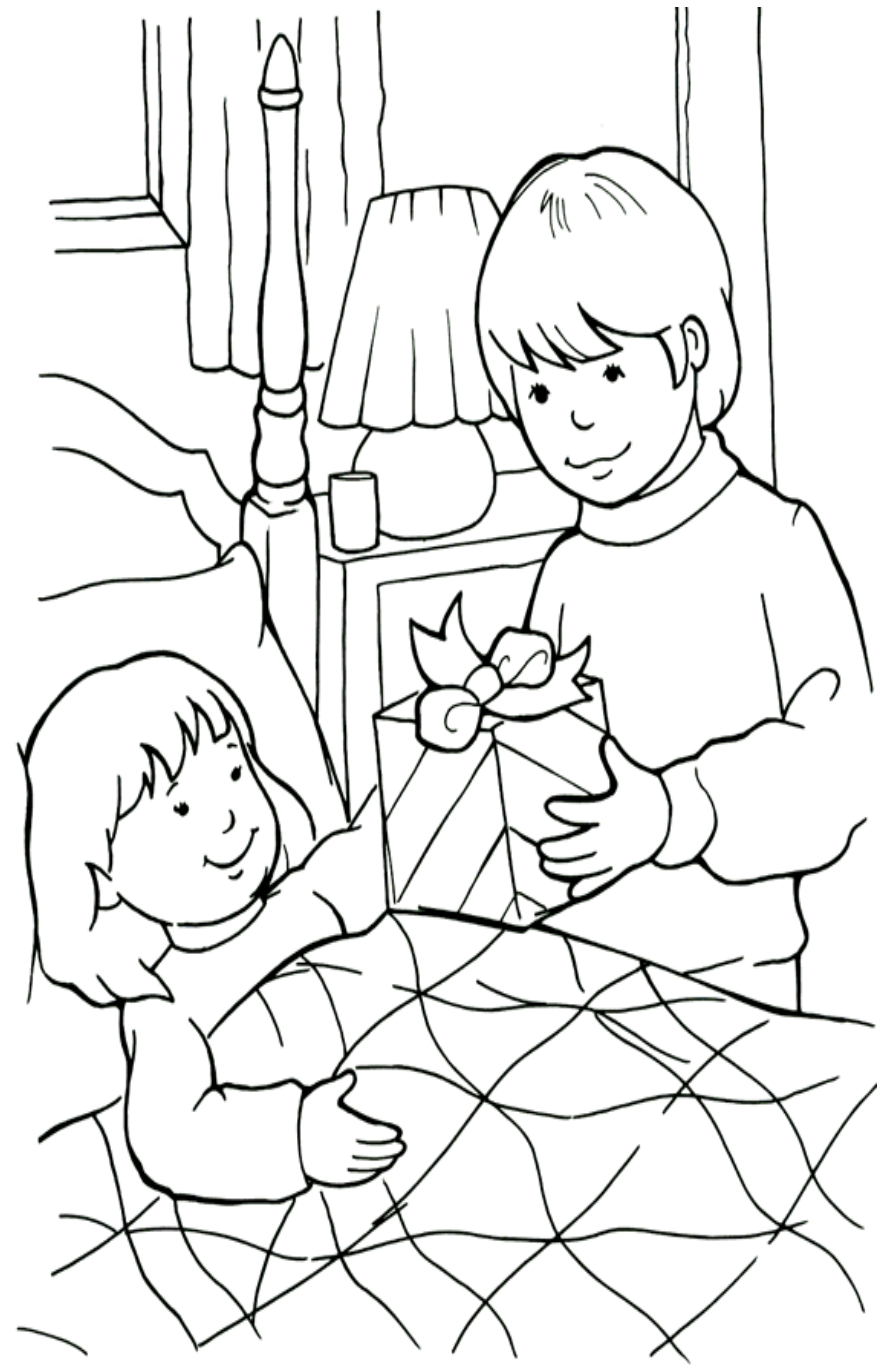
Blessed are Those Who Mourn

While **Jesus** was here on  , He taught  how to live. Some of the things **Jesus** taught are found in the  in Matthew **5** . We call them the *beatitudes*. Each of the beatitudes tells us something about what our **ATTITUDE** should **BE**. Each  starts with the word "Blessed".  of the meanings of "blessed" is  or joyful. A lot of  had come to see **Jesus**. He went  on the  (mountainside) and called his  (disciples) to Him. He began to  (teach) them saying, “Blessed are those who mourn  , for they shall

be  comforted. To mourn means to feel or express grief or sorrow; to show regret. Many things happen to us in life that bring us grief, but  will  comfort us when we turn to Him.  Corinthians :  says "Blessed be , even the Father  of our Lord Jesus Christ, the  of mercies, and the  of all ; {4}Who  eth us ... A person must also , or be  (sad) when he/she does things that make   because of disobedience. There are many "blessed" statements in Matthew :  - . Each of the "blessed" statements describes a person who puts  and other's interest above his/her own interest. We cannot be blessed if we live without being  and (regretful) for our sins.
