



# How Well Does God Know Me?

- “For thus says the LORD: After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place. 11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. 12 Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. 13 And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.”



# How Well Does God Really Know Me?


- God's knowledge of me is individual, not just another member of the vast human race
  - Jer. 29:11 - “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD...”

# How Well Does God Really Know Me?

- God's knowledge of me is intimate
  - Matt. 10:29-31 - "Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. 30 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. 31 Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows."


# How Well Does God Really Know Me?

  - Psalm 139:1-16




# How Well Does God Really Know Me?

- God's knowledge of me is instant
  - Job 42:2 - "I know that You can do everything, And that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You."
  - Prov. 21:2 - "Every way of a man is right in his own eyes, But the LORD weighs the hearts."
  - Prov. 15:3 - "The eyes of the LORD are in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good."
  - Isa. 46:10 - "Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure'"




# What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- God knows about my sins
  - Gen. 3:8-11 - “And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, Where are you? 10 So he said, I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself. 11 And He said, Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?”




# What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- God knows about my sins
  - Heb. 4:13 - “And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account”
  - Job 14:16 - “For now You number my steps, But do not watch over my sin.”
  - Psalm 90:8 - “You have set our iniquities before You, Our secret sins in the light of Your countenance.”




# What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- God knows about my sins
  - Prov. 28:13 - “He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.”
  - 1John 1:8-10 - “If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.”




## What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- God knows about my situations
  - Job 23:10 - “But He knows the way that I take; When He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.”
- He knows all about it; He is there with me
  - Heb. 13:5 - “...For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.”
  - Matt. 28:20 - “...and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age”



## What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- He cares about what I am facing
  - 1Peter 5:7 - “casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.”
  - Heb. 4:15 - “For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.”




# What Is Revealed By God's Knowledge Of Me?

- He has promised to bring me through
  - 1Cor. 10:13 - “No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.”
- He has promised me rest and peace in the middle of toil and turmoil
  - Matt. 11:28 - “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.”


# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in the past
  - Deut. 7:7-8 - “The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; 8 but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.”




# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in the past
  - Rev. 13:8 - "All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."
  - Eph. 1:4 - "just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love"
  - Titus 1:2 - "in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began"




# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in the past
  - 1Peter 1:18-19 - “knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”
  - John 3:16 - “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”




# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in the present
  - He is with us and for us
  - Matt. 6:25-33
  - Phil. 4:6-7, 19 - “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus... 19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”




# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in the present
  - Even in hardship... The prodigal son would not have gone home if it hadn't been for the time he spent starving in the hog pen
  - Luke 15:11-21



# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in promise
  - 2Cor. 4:16-18 - “Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. 17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, 18 while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.”



# How Does God Use His Knowledge Of Me?

- God's use in promise
  - Rom. 8:18 - "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."
  - Phil. 1:6 - "being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ"
