- Joh 5:22-27 NKJV; "For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son, 23 "that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. 24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life. 25 "Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will live. 26 "For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself, 27 "and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man.

- IMPLICATIONS OF LAW
 - LAW DEFINES SIN
 - LAW DEFINES PENALTY
 - FROM SIN TO CONSEQUENCE?

 - INVESTIGATION
 - 1Ti 5:24,25 NKJV; Some men's sins are clearly evident, preceding them to judgment, but those of some men follow later. 25 Likewise, the good works of some are clearly evident, and those that are otherwise cannot be hidden.

 - De 19:18 NKJV; "And the judges shall make careful inquiry, and indeed, if the witness is a false witness, who has testified falsely against his brother,

 - De 5:20 NKJV; 'You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
 - De 17:6 NKJV; "Whoever is deserving of death shall be put to death on the testimony of two or three witnesses; he shall not be put to death on the testimony of one witness

 - Pr 14:5 NKJV; A faithful witness does not lie, But a false witness will utter lies.
 - Pr 14:25 NKJV; A true witness delivers souls, But a deceitful witness speaks lies.

- Le 26:40-42 NKJV; 'But if they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers, with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked contrary to Me, 41 and that I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt- 42 then I will remember My covenant with Jacob, and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham I will remember; I will remember the land. ...

 - Ps 32:5 NKJV; I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah
 - Pr 28:13 NKJV; He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

- Ac 19:18 NKJV; And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds.
- Jas 5:16 NKJV; Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
- 1Jo 1:9 NKJV; If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

 - Ec 12:14 NKJV; For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.
 - 1Pe 4:45 NKJV; In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you. 5 They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

- 2Ki 15:5 NKJV; Then the LORD struck the king, so that he was a leper until the day of his death; so he dwelt in an isolated house. And Jotham the king's son was over the royal house, judging the people of the land.

■ PRONOUNCING JUDGMENT - SENTENCING

- De 17:9 NKJV; "And you shall come to the priests, the Levites, and to the judge there in those days, and inquire of them; they shall pronounce upon you the sentence of judgment.
- De 17:11 NKJV; "According to the sentence of the law in which they instruct you, according to the judgment which they tell you, you shall do; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left from the sentence which they pronounce upon you.

 - De 25:1 NKJV; "If there is a dispute between men, and they come to court, that the judges may judge them, and they justify the righteous and condemn the wicked,

- Joh 12:44-48 NKJV; Then Jesus cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me. 45 "And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me. 46 "I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness. 47 "And if anyone hears My words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. 48 "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him--the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

- Joh 5:22-30 NKJV cont.; 27 "and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man. 28 "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice 29 "and come forth--those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation. 30 "I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me.

- FINAL JUDGMENT
- 2Ti 4:6-8 NKJV; For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.
